2019 Sleeping Lady Mountain Lions Club Scholarships

Available scholarship amounts are determined by proceeds from the annual Sleeping Lady Mountain Lions Scholarship Fundraiser. This application will be utilized for the Shirley Littleton Legacy, Vi Thompson Memorial, and Sleeping Lady Mt Lions Scholarships.

Eligibility:

Applicant must be a 2019 graduating senior in the Chugiak-Eagle River school system with a minimum **2.5** GPA and demonstrate positive citizenship in the community. Applicants must live in the Chugiak- Eagle River community. Awards are for full time students, enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or degree at an accredited college or university. Students may also be enrolled in an apprenticeship program; trade school or technical or vocational school.

- A. Completed Scholarship Application Form;(signed by self and parent/guardian; include only past 4 years).
- B. Personal Essay not exceeding 1500 words double spaced to include information on what inspires you and How have you made a difference in your Community through Volunteerism?
- C. Transcript (signed by guidance counselor).
- D. Copy of SAT/ACT or Work Keys.
- E. Two letters of recommendations (academic/school and work/volunteer reference).
- F. Optional statement regarding any additional information to be considered by scholarship committee.
- G. Available for an interview if selected as a scholarship finalist.

Selection will be based on citizenship/volunteerism, academics, leadership and financial need. Scholarships may be revoked at the discretion of SLML scholarship committee. Scholarship recipients will be announced during 2019 Senior's Award Night. Awardees agree to be used in media or publicity releases concerning their award.

Prior to scholarship award disbursement, the recipient must submit verification of college/school enrollment. All scholarship awards will be made **Payable to the Accredited Educational Institution not the recipient.** All awards must be claimed by **Spring Semester or April 30, 2020**
