Eligibility:

Applicant must be a 2021 graduating senior in the Chugiak-Eagle River school system with a minimum 2.5GPA. The student must live in the Chugiak- Eagle River community. Awards are for full time students, in any course, which leads to a certificate or degree in an apprenticeship program; trade; technical or vocational school; or an accredited college/university.

Application Requirements:

1. Completed Scholarship Application For.
2. Personal Essay not exceeding 1,000 words, double spaced to include the following information.
 1. Tell us about yourself.
 2. Include a paragraph on "How you have made a difference in your community through volunteerism".
1. Transcript (signed by guidance counselor).
2. Copy SAT/ACT or Work Keys.
3. Two letters of recommendations (academic/school and work/volunteer reference).
4. Optional statement regarding any additional information to be considered by scholarship committee.
5. Available for an interview if selected as a scholarship finalist.

All documentation will be considered and kept confidential. The Scholarship Committee Selection will be based on residency, volunteerism, academics, leadership and need. Scholarship awards will be announced during Senior's Award Night.

Prior to scholarship award disbursement, the recipient must submit verification of college/school enrollment.

All scholarship awards will be made payable to the accredited educational institution not the recipient. All awards must be claimed by spring semester or April 30, 2022.
